## **Sherry E. Dalby**

Miss Sherry E. Dalby, daughter of former residents Mr. and Mrs. Maurice Dalby, now of Bethlehem, Pa., died March 6 of encephalitis at the Bible Clinic in San Jose, Costa Rica. She was 28.

Miss Dalby was to have taught in the Quaker Colony of Monte Verde, but before she could begin her duties on March 4, she was taken ill.

Born in New York, Miss Dalby was a member of the Class of 1963 of Chatham High School. Following her graduation from Skidmore College, she taught in Westchester (New York) County and earned a master's degree from Teachers College of Columbia University. Most recently, she was a teacher in Basalt, Colo., a town near Aspen where she lived.

In addition to her parents, she is survived by her maternal grandmother, Mrs. Nettye C. Jared of Murfreesboro, Tenn., a brother, Robert J. of Chatham; and a sister, Judith, at home.
