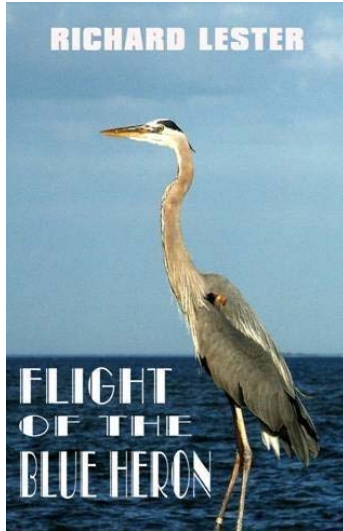


Flight of the Blue Heron Arrives Today
